

COMMENCEMENT OF SITE PREPARATION NOTICE

For the Grand Renewable Solar (GRS) Project, Grand Renewable Solar LP

Project Name: GRAND RENEWABLE SOLAR (GRS)

Project Location: County of Haldimand, Ontario.

Grand Renewable Solar LP is planning to engage in a renewable energy project for which a Renewable Energy Approval (REA) was issued by the Ministry of Environment on June 15, 2012. The Project, called the Grand Renewable Solar (GRS) Project is located in the County of Haldimand bounded by Mount Olivet Road to the west, Meadows Road to the north, Sutor Road to the east, and Haldimand Road 20 to the south for most of the site, with a small portion extending south of Haldimand Road 20. The Project will consist of solar modules, inverters, step up transformers, electrical collector lines, a transformer substation, transmission line access roads and construction staging areas.

Commencement of Construction-Related Activities:

Initial land clearing and grading activities for the access road and the Operations and Maintenance Building as described in the REA are scheduled to begin work as early as in August at 2788 Haldimand County Road 20 see Figure 1. All activities will be undertaken in accordance with Haldimand County by-laws to minimize noise disturbance to the local community. The following activities, managed by GRS LP, will last approximately 3 to 4 weeks: surveying, staking, grading of access roads and installation of temporary power and office space. Further Notice will be provided prior to the start of construction of the solar farm itself or other infrastructure not related to the activities described above.

Ongoing Communication:

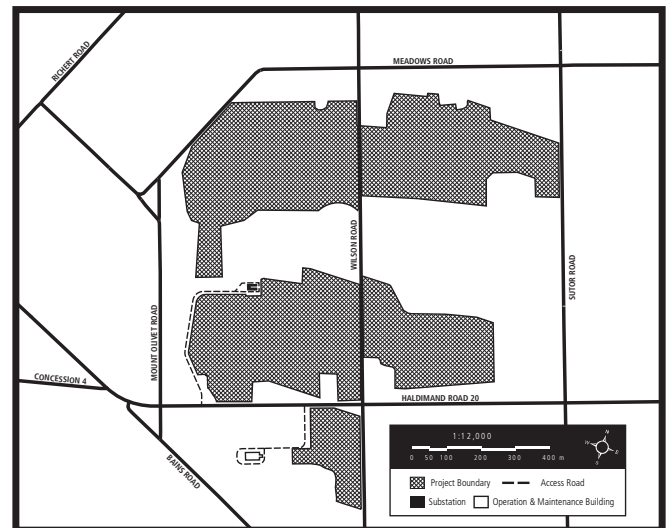
GRS LP has retained Samsung C&T Canada (SENC) as a construction contractor. SENC will be responsible for building the access road, the Operations and Maintenance Building, the Substation and the transmission line to be used by the Project.

GRS LP is committed to maintaining communication with local stakeholders and community members. We will be providing further notification in advance of solar facility construction. Haldimand County staff and elected council, regulatory agencies, local residents and Aboriginal communities will be notified of Project activities through newspaper advertisements, a mailing to the above-mentioned parties and a notice posted on the Project's website, www.samsungrenewableenergy.ca/haldimand.

GRS LP has developed a communication protocol that includes procedures for responding to and addressing comments and complaints. The protocol also requires that GRS LP notify the

Ministry of Environment should a complaint occur. GRS LP is pleased to continue strengthening our relationship and dialogue with the Haldimand County community by continuing to co-host the Community Liaison Committee (CLC) for the Grand Renewable Energy Park (GREP). Information regarding the GREP CLC is provided on the Project website.

GRS LP will maintain the Emergency Response Plan for the solar Project and provide protocols and procedures to follow for various scenarios. GRS LP will consult with Haldimand County staff on the draft Emergency Plan.
