We acknowledge receipt of your application for approval dated September 18, 2012 and received on September 21, 2012 for the following:

Approval Type: Renewable Energy Approval

Project Description: This proposal is for a new Renewable Energy Approval by Kingston Solar LP, located in Loyalist Township in the County of Lennox and Addington, Ontario. This proposed facility is a Class 3 Solar Facility with a nameplate capacity of 100 megawatts (MW).

Site Location: Unity Road and Mud Lake Road
North and south of Unity Road and Mud Lake Road
Loyalist Township, County of Lennox and Addington

The intent of the proposed solar facility is to connect to Hydro One's distribution system with electricity supplied to the provincial grid.

This facility is considered to be a Class 3 Solar Facility under Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 359/09 Renewable Energy Approvals under Part V.0.1 of the *Environmental Protection Act* (O. Reg. 359/09). Applications for Renewable Energy Approvals are required to be submitted in accordance with O. Reg. 359/09 for consideration for approval.

The Ministry has screened your submission and according to the requirements set out in O. Reg. 359/09 your application has been deemed complete. The Ministry will now begin our technical review of your submission. In accordance with our six month service standard, your application will be reviewed and a decision is expected to be made by August 12, 2013, provided that there are no significant issues raised during the Ministry's review.

Under Section 15.1 of O. Reg. 359/09, proponents are requested, within 10 days of the posting of the proposal notice on the Registry, to ensure that final copies of all submitted REA documents are posted on their website.

Under Section 15.2 of O. Reg. 359/09, proponents are requested, within 10 days of the posting of the proposal notice on the Registry, to publish a notice in a newspaper with general circulation in each local municipality in which the project location is situated. Details on what is to be included in the notice are provided in Section 15.2 of the Regulation.


Please note that should you require any other permits and/or approvals from other Provincial ministries or agencies, such as the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Ministry of Transportation or a conservation authority, please ensure that you contact that ministry or agency immediately to coordinate the timing of their approvals with the REA.
